Hearing on the request of Jim Zimmerman, agent for Girls Inc., to consider Case No. 06RVP-00000-00017, [application filed on April 20, 2006] to revise the Girls Inc. existing CUP (99-CP-098) to allow use of the facility by outside groups in compliance with Section 35.84.040 of the County Land Use and Development Code; and to approve the Addendum to Negative Declaration 00-ND-42 pursuant to the State Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act. There are no new significant environmental impacts as a result of this revision request. The original ND identified significant but mitigable effects on the environment in the following categories: Aesthetics/Visual Resources, Air Quality, Geologic Processes, Noise, Transportation/Circulation, and Water Resources/Flooding. Hearing on the request of the Santa Barbara County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, to consider Case No. 06GOV-00000-00030 [application filed on December 15, 2006] for a determination pursuant to Government Code Section 65402(c) as to whether the acceptance of an easement from the Land Trust for Santa Barbara County to allow Flood Control to access Franklin Creek via an existing dirt road for the removal of soil and sediment therefrom, and to temporarily store said material on the Property within an existing debris basin adjacent to the dirt road until it is dry enough to be moved, as part of the Carpinteria Salt Marsh Enhancement Plan, is consistent with the Comprehensive Plan of the County of Santa Barbara. The application involves AP No. 004-031-011, located in Basin 1, in the Carpinteria Salt Marsh, in the Carpinteria area, First Supervisorial District.
