Hearing on the request of Urban Planning Concepts, agent for the owner, Orcutt Aquacenter Inc. [applications filed on October 12, 2000] to consider the following:

- a) **01CUP-00000-00115** for a Conditional Use Permit allowing “sports and outdoor recreational facilities” in compliance with Sections 35.23.030 and 35.82.060 of the County Land Use and Development Code, on property zoned DR-3.3;
- b) **00DVP-00000-06009** for approval of a Final Development Plan in compliance with Sections 35.23.030 and 35.82.060 of the County Land Use and Development Code, on property zoned DR-3.3, to develop the Orcutt Aquacenter swimming and recreation facility;

and to approve the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration 06NGD-00000-00021 pursuant to the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act. As a result of this project, significant but mitigable effects on the environment are anticipated in the following categories: aesthetics (design compatibility, light and glare), air quality (dust generation), biological resources (nesting birds and native vegetation removal), geology (erosion, sedimentation and water quality), hazardous materials (potential for discovery of contaminated soil), land use (airport-related conflicts), noise (short-term construction and public address system use), and water resources (long-term water quality). The application involves AP No. 107-470-011, located near the southeast corner of Union Valley Parkway and Hummel Drive, in the Orcutt area, Fourth Supervisorial District. Proposals to allow Zoning Clearances following CUP

3. 7ORD-00000-00001 and DP Approvals and Revisions to the CDP Process Countywide

The County Planning Commission will consider ordinance amendments on proposals to amend the County and Land Use and Development Code to allow Zoning Clearances following Conditional Use Permit and Development Plan approvals and revisions to the Coastal Development Permit process as follows:

- a) **07ORD-00000-00001**, to adopt a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors that the Board of Supervisors adopt an ordinance amending the text of Article 35.8, Planning Permit Procedures, of Section 35-1, the Santa Barbara County Land Use and Development Code, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code, and recommend that the Board of Supervisors find that Case No. 07ORD-00000-00001 is exempt from environmental review pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the State Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act.

These amendments relate to:

- Use of the Zoning Clearance process to allow development following Conditional Use Permit and Development Plan approvals;
- Revisions to the Coastal Development Permit process; including designating the Director as the review authority for Coastal Development Permits with waived public hearings.
