Hearing on the request of the Planning and Development Department that the Montecito Planning Commission reconsider their previous action of September 26, 2012, and adopt a revised recommendation as follows:

a) 12ORD-0000-00012. Adopt a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors that the Board adopt an ordinance (Case No. 12ORD-00000-00012) amending Division 35.3, Montecito Site Planning and Other Project Standards, Division 35.10, Glossary, and add a new Appendix H titled "Agricultural Buffer Implementation Guidelines" of Section 35-2, the Santa Barbara County Montecito Land Use and Development Code, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County code;

and to recommend that the Board of Supervisors adopt the Final Negative Declaration (11NGD-00000-00004) pursuant to the State Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act. The purpose of the proposed ordinance is to create and implement an Agricultural Buffer Ordinance.

Cottage Food Ordinance Amendments

Exempt, CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3)

Hearing on the request of the Planning and Development Department that the Montecito Planning Commission:

- a) 13ORD-0000-00003. Adopt a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors that Board adopt an ordinance (Case No. 13ORD-00000-00003) amending Division 35.4, Montecito Standards for Specific Land Uses, and Division 35.10, Glossary, of Section 35-2, the Santa Barbara County Montecito Land Use and Development Code, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code;
- b) 13ORD-00000-00004. Adopt a recommendation to the County Planning Commission that the County Planning Commission recommended to the Board of Supervisors that the Board adopt an ordinance (Case No. 13ORD-00000-00004) amending Division 2, Definitions, and Division 7, General Regulations, of Article II, the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code;

and to recommend that the Board of Supervisors determine that this ordinance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the Guidelines for Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act. The purpose of these amendments is to implement the requirements of State laws AB1616 (Cottage Food Operations) and AB2297 (California Retail Food Code) by revising the Home Occupations sections of the zoning ordinances by establishing an administrative permitting process and reasonable land use development standards for cottage food operations to be conducted as an accessory use within existing dwelling units that may include the preparation of specified food items, and the sale thereof, in and from dwellings.

ACTION:

Made the findings for approval, including CEQA findings and recommend that the Board of Supervisors make the required findings for approval; Recommend that the Board of Supervisors determine the ordinances are exempt from CEQA; and adopt resolutions recommending that the Board of Supervisors recommending that the Board of Supervisors adopt Case No. 13ORD-00000-00003 and recommending that the County Planning Commission adopt a resolution recommend that the Board of Supervisors approve Case No. 13ORD-00000-00004.
