Chair Burrows expressed condolences on behalf of the Commission to the families of the Granite Mountain Hotshots team who passed away while fighting the Yarnell Hill wildfire in Arizona, including local Sean Misner, and suggested that members of the public contact the Montecito Fire Protection District for more information and/or to show their support. Commissioner Brown attended the July Montecito Association land use committee meeting, reporting that HLAC Commissioner D. L. J. suggested that the Montecito Association regenerate the historic resources list that has been in the works since 1992. She also attended a recent MBAR meeting and expressed interest in the square footage of projects that they are reviewing, and commented that the MBAR is once again meeting once every two weeks. Commissioner Brown also attended a recent Montecito Fire Protection District meeting and reported that plans for Fire Station #3 have been rescinded. The City of Santa Barbara Planning Commission will be having a disaster preparedness presentation given to them, and Commissioner Brown suggested that perhaps the MPC could receive a similar presentation during one of their shorter hearings. Commissioner Eidelson recently served as the Grand Marshall for Montecito's Fourth of July parade, and the Commission expressed their support and appreciation of him.

The project is a request for a Coastal Development Permit to allow for the reconstruction of approximately 600 square feet of roof area of an existing residence. The roof change would convert the existing flat roof to a pitched roof. No grading will be required to carry out the project and no trees would be removed. The parcel is currently developed with an approximately 3,300 square foot single-family residence and an 800 square foot detached garage. The property is a 0.51-acre parcel zoned 20-R-1 and shown as AP No. 007-350-016, located at 116 Arroqui Street in the Montecito Community Plan Area, First Supervisorial District.

Hearing on the request of Ken Mineau, agent for the owners Ross Bagdasarian and Janice Karman, and Sheila and Michael Bonsignore, to consider Case No. 09LLA-00000-00003 [application filed on April 15, 2009], for approval of a Lot Line Adjustment in compliance with Section 21-90 of County Code Chapter 21 and Section 35.430.110 of the Montecito Land Use and Development Code to adjust lines between two existing lots of 3.00 (Lot 1) and 3.23 (Lot 2) acres (gross) to reconfigure into two lots of 2.92 (Lot 1) and 3.31 (Lot 2) acres (gross), on property located in the 2-E-1 and 3-E-1 zones; and to determine the project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15305(a).
