Hearing on the request of the Planning and Development Department that the Montecito Planning Commission consider the following:

- a) **11ORD-00000-00030.** Adopt a resolution recommending the Board of Supervisors amend the Santa Barbara County Montecito Land Use and Development Code, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code; and
